Gentlemen:

In accordance with Fowler Blinebry Pool rules (Order R-2424-A), Pan American Petroleum Corporation submits this application for administrative approval of exceptions to Rules 2 & 4 for a non-standard proration unit and an unorthodox well location for our State 'D' Well No. 3, located 330' FNL and 2050' FEL, Section 16, T-24-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

This well was originally drilled and completed as a Fowler Devonian Oil well. The Devonian zone has now been depleted. Since there are re-completion possibilities in the Blinebry zone, we propose to open various intervals between 5509'-5594', and evaluate. Too, this well is located on a single quarter-quarter section, necessitating a non-standard proration unit.

All offset operators have been notified by certified mail of our intention to file this application.


