

Atlantic Richfield respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, Rule 29, for a 40-acre non-standard Blinebry Gas proration unit for the Roy Barton No. 4 well, located 1750' FNL and 1980' FEL, Sec. 23, T-21S, R-37E, in Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed proration unit will comprise the SW/4, NE/4 of Sec. 23, as shown on the attached plat.

The Roy Barton No. ⁴4 is a former oil well in the Blinebry Oil Pool. It was reclassified under R-1670, Rules 27 and 28, to Blinebry Gas as of December 1, 1970, because of a high gas-oil ratio. The well is awaiting connection to the El Paso gathering system and assignment of a provisional gas allowable.
