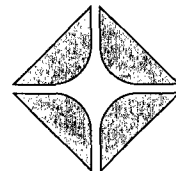

Gentlemen:

You are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate a 160-acre proration unit, previously approved under Administrative Order NSP-1106, comprising the NW/4 of Section 27, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, to your Shipley "A" WN Well No. 6, located 1650 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line and your Shipley "A" WN Well No. 1, located 990 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the West line, both in said Section 27, Lea County, New Mexico.

Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable from any of the wells on the proration unit in any proportion.
