On April 17, 1989, the Oil Conservation Division office in Santa Fe received your letter of objection to the subject filing dated April 14, 1989, see attached. Said application from ARCO was received on March 15, 1989 and Administrative Order NSP-1570(L)(SD), also attached, was issued on April 6, 1989. This application met all of the requirements in Rules 2(c) and 2(a)4 of Division Order R-8170, as amended, and was therefore approved subsequent to the required 20-day waiting period. Since your letter of objection was not filed with the Division within the prescribed waiting period, the Administrative Order will not be affected. However, if you still wish to follow through with your objection, an application by Texaco for a hearing to review and rescind said Order NSP-1570(L)(SD) will be required.

Reference is made to your application of March 13, 1989, for a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 21: W/2

Said unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to the following three existing wells all on the W.C. Roach Lease in the W/2 of said Section 21:

Well No. 1 located 330 feet from the North and West lines (Unit D);

Well No. 6 located 660 feet from the North and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit C); and,

Well No. 7 located at a standard gas well location for the proposed unit, 1980 feet from the South and West lines (Unit K).

It is my understanding that the Eumont Gas Pool underlying the W/2 of said Section 21 is presently developed by two 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration units, both authorized by Division Administrative Order NSP-1196. The NW/4 being simultaneously dedicated to the W.C. Roach Wells No. 1 and 6 and the SW/4 being dedicated to the W.C. Roach Well No. 7.

The W.C. Roach Wells No. 1 and 6 are located at unorthodox gas well locations for the proposed 320-acre unit (Rule 2(b)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended); however the No. 1 well was drilled and completed prior to the creation of the Eumont Gas Pool and its location is therefore authorized under the provisions of Rule 2(b)2 of the Eumont Special Rules. At this time the location of the Well No. 6 is hereby approved pursuant to Rule 2(c) of said Order No. R-8170, as amended.

Furthermore, by authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of said Order No. R-8170, the above-described 320-acre gas proration unit is hereby approved.

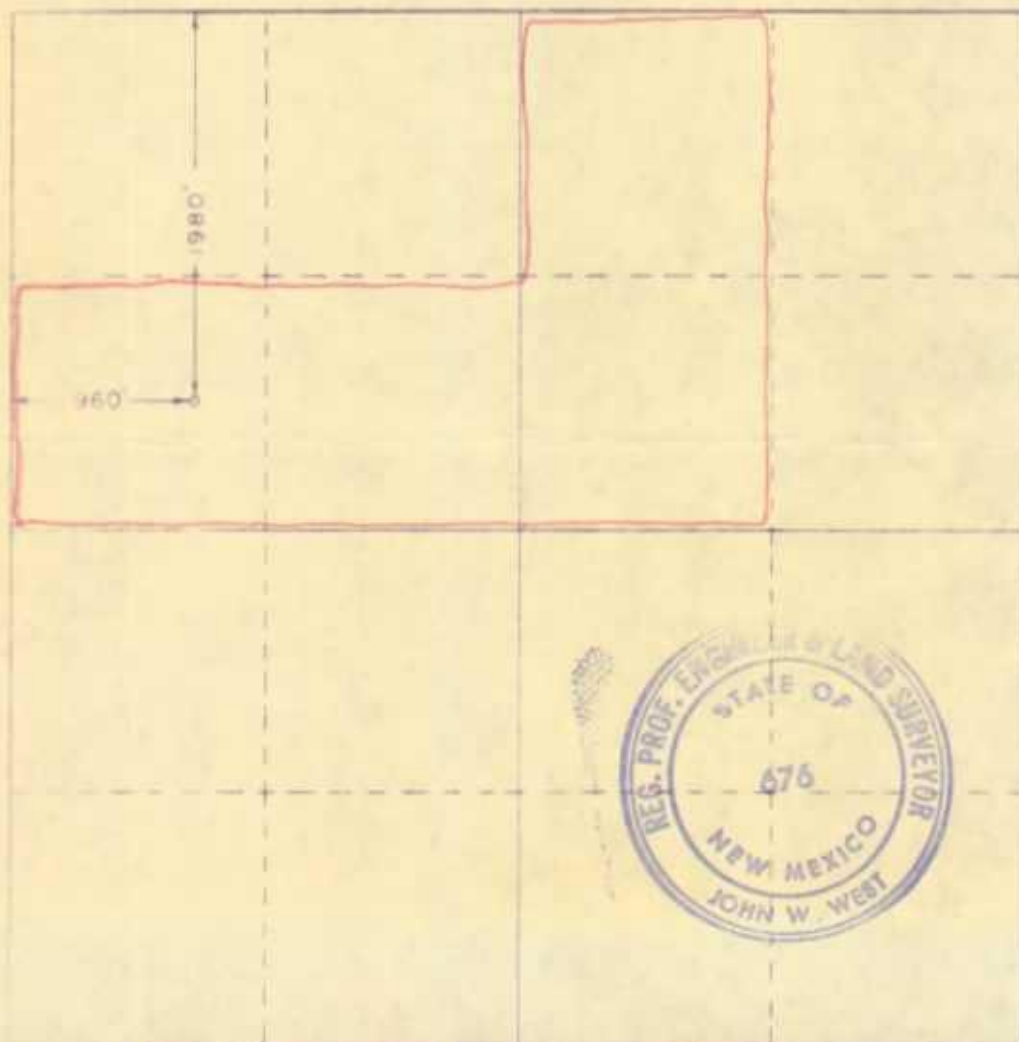
