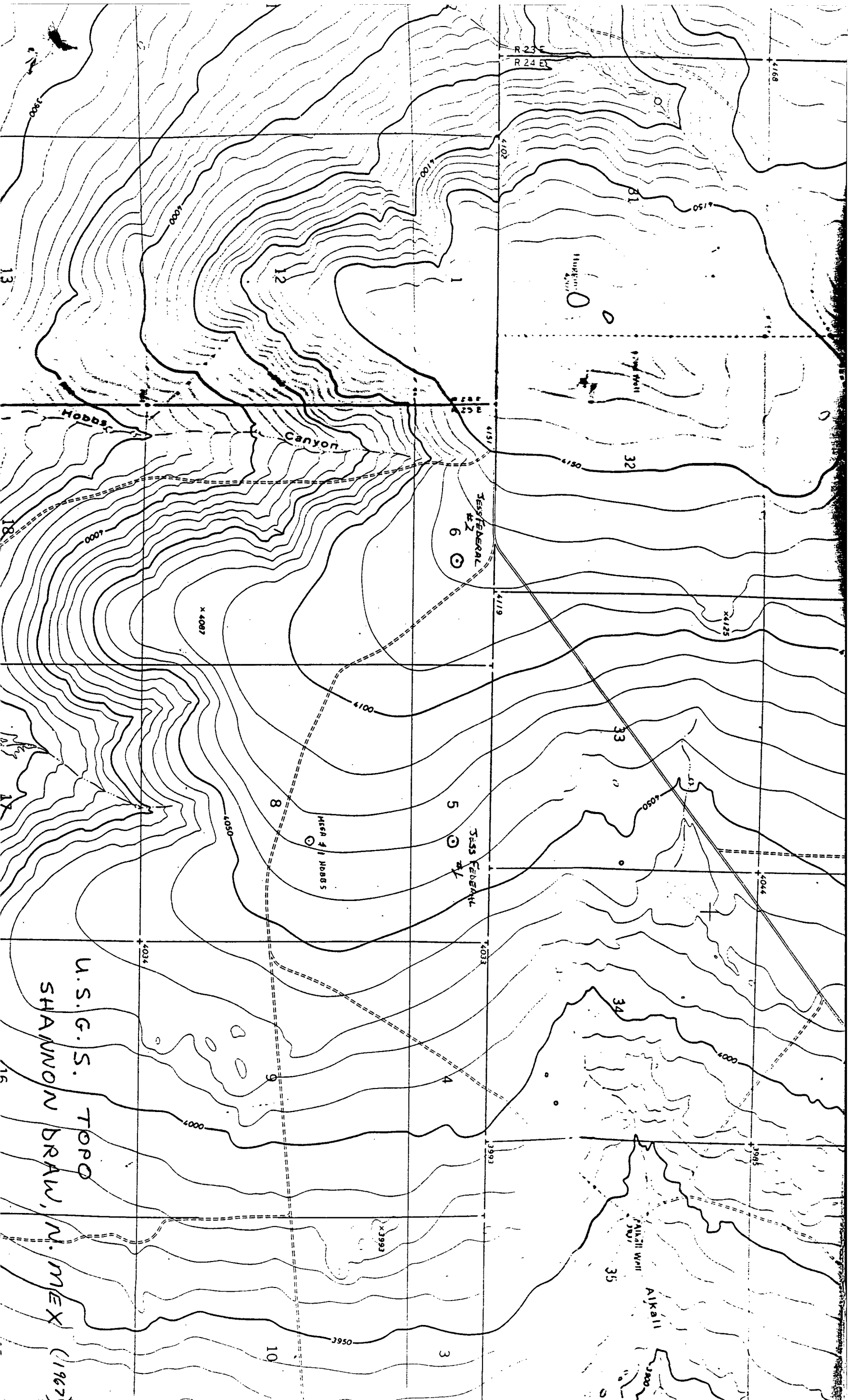

Application is hereby made for an administrative approval for a non-standard shaped gas proration unit for the above captioned wells. The locations are orthodox for the Abo formation being applied for and sufficient acreage is available, 185 acres for the Jess Federal #1 and 188 acres for the Jess Federal #2, but due to survey anomalies of these sections as indicated on the attached plat the units must be rectangular in shape instead of square as is normal for 160 acre units.
