Please consider this Maralo's request for an administrative approval for a Non-Standard Unit for the captioned well. Rule 104 II (a) states that a well of Pennsylvanian age or older shall be located on a designated drilling tract consisting of 320 surface contiguous acres, more or less, comprising any two contiguous quarter sections of a single governmental section, being a legal subdivision of the U. S. Public Land Surveys. Any well having more than 160 acres dedicated to it shall be located not closer than 660' to the nearest side boundary of the dedicated tract nor closer than 1980' to the nearest end boundary nor closer than 330' to any quarter-quarter section or subdivision inner boundary.

We propose that the captioned well have 80 surface contiguous acres, more or less, comprising of the West half of the Southeast quarter of Section 30, T-16-S, R-36-E and being located 660' FSL & 500' FEL of the quarter/quarter and 660' FSL & 1830' FEL of the quarter Section 30

Maralo is in compliance with Rule 104 II (a)(b)(c) and (d) as follows:

- (a) The non-standard unit consist of quarter-quarter sections or lots that are contiguous by a common bordering side. A plat is attached outlining the proposed unit.
- (b) The non-standard unit lies wholly within a single governmental quarter section.
- (c) See paragraph (d).
- (d) In lieu of paragraph (c) of this Rule, attached is proof of the fact that each of the offset operators were notified by certified mail of Maralo's intent to form a non-standard unit. We understand that the Director may approve our application if no such operator has entered an objection to the formation of such non-standard unit






