Amended Administrative Order NSP-1578(L)

Dear Ms. Bradfield:


Reference is made to your applications dated April 10 and June 21, 1990 to amend the unorthodox location of your proposed Rosa Unit Well No. 241 (which was the subject of division Administrative Order NSP-1578(L), dated July 18, 1989) from the previously approved location 535 feet from the South line and 685 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to a new location being 2090 feet from the South line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit I) of said Section 6.

It is our understanding that the proposed change was necessitated due to an archeological site at the old location.

The applicant in this matter, Meridian Oil, Inc., who assumed operatorship of the subject wellsite and the Rosa Unit on October 20, 1989 has made a proper filing to amend the subject location pursuant to Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768. The subject application is hereby approved and said Order NSP-1578(L) is hereby amended to reflect the well location for the Rosa Unit No. 241 as 2090 feet from the South line and 790 feet from the East line (Unit I) of said Section 6.

All other provisions of original Order NSP-1578(L) shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
