
Reference is made to your application dated April 25, 1990 for a 199.00-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool:

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, NMPM
Section 6: Lots 3 through 7, SE/4 NW/4, E/2 SW/4 (W/2 equivalent)

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your Prichard Federal Well No. 7 to be drilled at a non-standard coal gas well location 1185 feet from the South line and 1200 feet from the West line (Unit N) of said Section 6, hereby approved pursuant to the provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768.
