Reference is made to your application dated April 22, 1991 for a 232.73-acre, more or less, non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool:

RIO ARRIBA, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 29 NORTH, RANGE 6 WEST, NMPM


Section 1: Lots 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 14 and 15, the SW/4 NE/4, and that portion of Tract No. 37 lying east of the projected north/south line which separates Lots 6 and 11 and the SW/4 NE/4 of the Section with Lots 7 and 12 and the SE/4 NW/4 of this section (E/2 equivalent) as shown on the official U. S. Public Land Resurvey dated July 19, 1915.

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your San Juan 29-6 Unit Well No. 237 drilled at a standard coal gas well location 1189 feet from the North line and 1106 feet from the East line (Unit B) of said Section 1.

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By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 6 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, the above non-standard gas proration unit is hereby approved.
