Reference is made to your application dated November 18, 1991 for an 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Jalmat Gas Pool:

## LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 17: W/2 NW/4

It is our understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your existing Langlie - Mattix "B-4" Penrose (Queen) Unit Well No. 11 (formerly the Hughes "B-4" Well No. 11) which was drilled in 1965 and completed in the Langlie - Mattix Pool at a standard oil well location 660 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the West line (Unit D) of said Section 17. We further understand that the existing Queen interval will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Jalmat Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, is unorthodox.

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By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)9 and 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described non-standard gas proration unit and resulting unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved.
