
Reference is made to your application dated August 4, 1994 for a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Jalmat Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 33: SW/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to the existing Arnott Ramsey NCT-D Well No. 9 (API No. 30-025-04890), located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 33.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described non-standard gas spacing and proration unit, with allowable assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 5 of said special pool rules based upon the unit size of 160 acres.
