Dear Mr. Kacir:

Reference is made to your application dated June 6, 1997 for a 120-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") consisting of the following acreage in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO <u>TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM</u> Section 35: NE/4 SW/4 and S/2 SW/4.

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to your existing Mark Owen Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-25481) located at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of said Section 35, the Mark Owen Well No. 3 (API No. 30-025-07038) located at a standard gas well location 660 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit N) of said Section 35, and the Mark Owen Well No. 4 (API No. 30-025-07040) located at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the South and West lines (Unit K) of said Section 35.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 4(b)2 of the "Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool" as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the abovedescribed 120-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit is hereby approved. Also, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU, in accordance with Rule 5 of said pool rules based upon a unit size of 120 acres.
