STATEMENT OF THE CASE

EGL Resources, Inc. and Robert Landreth seek an order pooling all mineral interests from the base of the Morrow formation to the base of the Devonian formation, North Bell Lake-Devonian Gas Pool, in the 640-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 34 East. Said unit is to be dedicated the Rio Blanco "4" Federal Well No. 1 to be re-entered at a standard gas well location 1980 feet from the North and West lines (Unit F) of said Section 4. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 20 miles southwest of Eunice, New Mexico.
