Applicant owns certain working interests in and under the N/2 of Section

2. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced pooled units to its Uncle Buck "3" No. 1 Com Well to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1200' from the North line and 1800' from the East line of said Section 3 to a depth sufficient to test the Atoka and Morrow formations underlying the N/2 of Section 3.
