13 the pooling in this case, Mr. Derrel Melton.

14 The case was presented two months ago. The
15 parties at that time were discussing, had reached a verbal
16 agreement. We asked the case be continued until the
17 documents were, in fact, signed, and I can advise the
18 Division that those documents have been signed, that Mr.
19 Melton is now voluntarily committed to the well, and we --
20 therefore there's no reason to delay entering the pooling
21 order requested by Concho.

22 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, the case was heard by
23 Examiner Catanach, and if you could refer back to him,
24 there are several additional parties who still need to be
25 pooled, who did not show up at the hearing.

1 EXAMINER JONES: Okay, without more discussion on
2 that case we will thank you very much, both, both of you
3 very much, and we'll take Case 13,217 under advisement, Mr.
4 Catanach will.
