APPLICATION

PRESTON EXPLORATION, L.L.C., by its undersigned attorneys, Miller, Stratvert P.A., (J. Scott Hall) hereby makes application pursuant to NMSA 1978 Section 70-2-17 (1995) for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Morrow formation (undesignated POW-Morrow Gas Pool) underlying the N/2 of Section 32, Township 16 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, to form a standard 320-acre spacing and proration unit for the referenced formation and pool. Applicant would show the Division:

1. Applicant owns certain working interests in and under the N/2 of Section 32, and has the right to drill thereon.
2. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced unit to its San Remo 32 Com No. 1 Well to be drilled at a standard gas well location 1980' from the North line and 2130' from the West line of said Section 32 to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation.
3. Applicant has sought but has been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from certain other interest owners in the above-referenced formations underlying the N/2 of said Section 32.

4. In order to permit the Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, the mineral interests should be pooled and Applicant should be designated operator of the well.

5. The pooling of interests will afford the Applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of hydrocarbons underlying the spacing unit, will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE Applicant requests that this Application be set for hearing before a duly appointed examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on July 8, 2004 and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its Order pooling the lands, designating Applicant as operator, including provisions for Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well, and the allocation of the cost thereof, its costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, including overhead charges and providing for adjustments to such rates in accordance with accepted COPAS accounting procedures, and imposing a 200% risk factor for the risk assumed by the Applicant in drilling, completing and equipping the well, and making such other and further provisions as may be proper.

CASE 13295: **Application of Preston Exploration, L.L.C. for compulsory pooling, Eddy County New Mexico.** Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Morrow formation, (undesigned POW-Morrow Pool) underlying the N/2 of Section 32, Township 16 South, Range 26 East to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to applicant's San Remo 32 Com No. 1 Well to be located at a standard gas well location 1980' from the North line and 2130' from the West line of said Section 32. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Preston Exploration, L.L.C. as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is to be located approximately 2 miles northwest of Artesia, New Mexico.

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
