You are hereby notified that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has filed the referenced application, a copy of which is enclosed herewith, seeking an order requiring you to bring a specified inactive well in Eddy County, New Mexico into compliance with Division Rule 201.B, by either restoring such well to production or beneficial use, permanently plugging and abandoning or temporarily abandoning same. In addition, the Division seeks assessment of civil penalties for your failure to comply with previous administrative notices to bring this well into compliance.

A hearing on this Application will take place before a Division hearing examiner on Thursday, May 8, 2003, at 8:15 a.m., in Porter Hall, First Floor, 1220 South St. Francis Drive in Santa Fe, New Mexico.
