STATEMENT OF CASE

OPPOSITION

Yates Petroleum Corporation opposes the application of Chesapeake for approval of an unorthodox location for its Boyce "15" Well No. 5 in Unit B of Section 15, Township 16 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in the North Shoe Bar-Atoka Gas Pool. Although this well was only permitted as a Strawn test, Chesapeake drilled through the Strawn formation and completed the well in the deeper Atoka formation. While the well location was standard in the Strawn it is unorthodox in the Atoka. Yates is the operator of the offsetting acreage on which the Chesapeake well encroaches. A well at the Chesapeake location will drain Atoka reserves from Yates and its location 330 feet from the common spacing unit boundary line could prevent Yates from drilling an economic offset Atoka well. If this location is approved, the Division should severely penalize the well to offset the advantage Chesapeake is gaining on Yates and to discourage future disregard for Oil Conservation Division rules.
