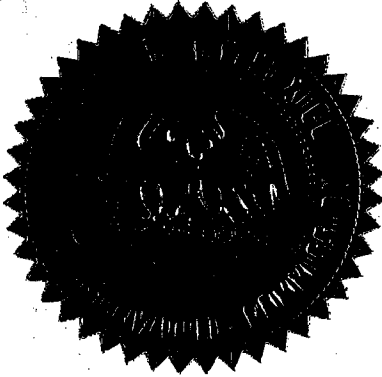
**FINDS:**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**


1. The application in this case is hereby dismissed.
