Brenner, Certified Court Reporter No. 7 for the State of New Mexico.

WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 8:17 a.m.: 2 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: ...call Case Number 13,340, 3 4 which is the Application of McElvain Oil and Gas 5 Properties, Inc., for compulsory pooling, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. 6 7 Now I call for appearances. 8 MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiner, 9 Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of the law firm 10 of Holland and Hart, appearing on behalf of the Applicant, McElvain Oil and Gas Properties, Inc., and I have one 11 12 witness today. 13 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any other appearances? Okay, let the witness stand to be sworn, please. 14 15 (Thereupon, the witness was sworn.) EXAMINER EZEANYIM: And Mr. Feldewert, you can 16 continue. 17 18 DENISE GREER, 19 the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon 20 her oath, was examined and testified as follows: 21 DIRECT EXAMINATION 22 BY MR. FELDEWERT: Would you please state your full name and where 23 Q. 24 you reside for the record? 25 Denise Greer, in Denver, Colorado. Α.

1	Q. And by whom are you employed and in what
2	capacity?
3	A. I'm employed by McElvain Oil and Gas Properties
4	as a landman.
5	Q. And have you previously testified before this
6	Division?
7	A. No, I have not.
8	Q. How many years have you been employed as a
9	landman for McElvain?
10	A. For McElvain, for the last three and a half
11	years.
12	Q. And prior to that, how many How many years of
13	experience do you have as a landman?
14	A. Total experience, 29 years.
15	Q. And has your work focused on northwest New
16	Mexico?
17	A. Since I've been with McElvain I have focused on
18	northwest New Mexico, for three and a half years.
19	Q. Are you a member of any professional
20	organization?
21	A. The Denver Association of Petroleum Landmen, for
22	the last five years.
23	Q. And are you familiar with the Application that's
24	been filed by McElvain in this case?
25	A. Yes, I am.

1	Q. And are you familiar with the status of the lands
2	in the subject area?
3	A. Yes, I am.
4	MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, I would tender Ms.
5	Greer as an expert witness in petroleum land matters.
6	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Ms. Greer is so qualified.
7	Q. (By Mr. Feldewert) Why don't you turn to
8	McElvain Exhibit Number 1, identify it and explain to the
9	Examiner what McElvain seeks with this Application?
LO	A. Exhibit Number 1 is a nine-section land map which
L1	shows the location of the well that we're proposing to
L2	drill in Section 14 of 25 North, 2 West.
L3	Q. And you're requesting to pool what acreage?
4	A. The west half of Section 14.
L5	Q. And is this from the surface down to the base of
L6	the Mesaverde formation?
L7	A. Yes, it is.
L8	Q. And are you seeking to pool for all formations or
L9	pools that are developed on 320-acre spacing?
20	A. Yes, we are.
21	Q. Now, does this exhibit show the well to which
22	this west-half 320-acre spacing unit is to be dedicated?
23	A. Yes, it does, it's the McElvain Badger 14 Number
24	1 well, up in the northwest quarter of Section 14.
5	O Is that well to be drilled at a standard

location? 1 2 Α. Yes, it is. What's the footage location for this well? 3 0. 785 feet from the north line and 1290 feet from 4 Α. the west line. 5 6 0. Now, what is the status of the acreage in this area? 7 The acreage in this area is fee acreage. 8 Okay. Now why don't we turn to McElvain Exhibit 9 Q. Identify that and review that for the Examiner, 10 Number 2. 11 please. Exhibit Number 2 is the initial letter that we 12 13 sent out to owners in the west half of this section, proposing to drill the well. It outlines the ownership 14 15 that would be under that spacing unit, along with our AFE. 16 Q. Okay. Now, does this list the parties that are 17 subject to the pooling application here today? 18 Α. Yes, it does. Okay, and is it marked on this exhibit on the 19 0. first page at the bottom with dashes next to the names? 20 Yes, it does. 21 A. And how many parties are subject to this pooling 22 Q. 23 Application? 24 Α. There are three that are -- still need to be

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subject to this agreement.

- Q. Okay, why don't you identify them for the record?
- A. Four Star Oil & Gas Company, San Juan Gas Corporation, and Christopher Phillips.
- Q. Of these three interest owners are there any interest owners you have been unable to locate?
 - A. Christopher Phillips we've been unable to locate.
- Q. Okay, and he's shown as having a 1.5-percent interest in this 120-acre spacing unit?
 - A. Yes, he is.

- Q. Why don't you outline for the Examiner your efforts to locate this individual?
- A. We have -- not only did we send this initial letter by certified mail -- it was returned to us as vacant, nobody lived there -- we've also searched down a second address for him by contacting another company that's active in this area that had previously done business with him. That address also has not proven to be a correct address; the people there have called us and said that he's no longer there. We've done Internet search, looking for him in Tulsa, Oklahoma. We've also talked to an attorney that used to handle some of his affairs, and he only had the addresses that we currently have for him.
- Q. Now, why don't you then summarize your efforts to obtain voluntary joinder of the two interest owners that you have been able to locate?

A. That would be Four Star Oil & Gas Company and San

Juan Gas Corporation. We have sent them this May 11th

letter. We also then re-sent information to them July

27th, I believe it was. And I have talked to Four Star Oil

& Gas Company on several occasions, and they've just been

unable to make any decision. They're aware that we are

here before this hearing today.

San Juan Gas Corporation, we've made several attempts to contact the primary owner of that corporation and we have not had our phone calls returned.

- Q. So have you left messages with the principal of San Juan Gas?
 - A. Yes, we have.
 - Q. Who is the principal for San Juan Gas?
 - A. Alex Phillips.
 - Q. Okay.

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- A. And he also signed the certified slips and the Federal Express packages when we sent --
- Q. And the telephone number that you called and left messages on, you're confident that that's a correct number for Alex Phillips of San Juan Gas?
 - A. Yes, we are.
 - Q. And he has not returned your phone calls.
- Q. And they've also received, I think you said, not only your initial letter that's been marked as Exhibit

Number 2, but also a follow-up letter in July? 1 2 A. Yes. 3 And they have not contacted you in response to Q. those letters? 4 5 Α. No response. In your opinion, have you made a good faith 6 0. 7 effort to locate and obtain voluntary joinder of the three interest owners that are the subject of this pooling 8 9 Application today? 10 Yes, we have. Α. Now, this exhibit -- this document that's been 11 Q. marked as Exhibit Number 2, it contains an AFE, does it 12 not? 13 14 A. Yes, it does. Why don't you review the dryhole and completed 15 Q. well costs, if you are successful, with the Examiner? 16 17 The dryhole cost would total \$389,220, the total Α. completed well would be \$713,980. 18 19 Okay. Now, has McElvain drilled similar wells in Q. 20 this area? 21 Yes, we have, up in Section 10 and Section 11, Α. 22 we've drilled wells. 23 Okay, and that's shown on McElvain Exhibit Number Q. 1? 24 25 Yes, they are. Α.

1	Q. All right. Are these costs in line with what
2	McElvain has incurred for drilling similar wells in this
3	area?
4	A. Yes, they are.
5	Q. Have you made an estimate of the overhead and
6	administrative cost while drilling this well, also while
7	producing this well, if you are successful?
8	A. Yes, for drilling overhead it would be \$5500 a
9	month, and for producing overhead \$550.
10	Q. Now, the interest owners that are shown on
11	McElvain Exhibit Number 2, have some or all of them signed
12	a joint operating agreement?
13	A. Yes, we've had some of them sign the joint
14	operating agreement; others, we've gone ahead and purchased
15	their interests or obtained a different agreement from
16	them.
17	Q. These overhead figures that you've set forth here
18	today, are these the rates that are included in the JOA for
19	this property?
20	A. Yes, they are.
21	Q. And do you recommend that these figures be
22	incorporated into any order that results from this hearing?
23	A. Yes, I do.
24	Q. And does McElvain request that these overhead

figures approved by the Division be subject to adjustment

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in accordance with the applicable COPAS guidelines? 1 Yes, I do. 2 Α. 3 What entity will be the designated operator of Q. the proposed well? 4 McElvain Oil and Gas Properties, Inc. 5 Α. And that is the Applicant named here today? 6 Q. 7 Α. Yes. 8 All right. And does McElvain request that the Q. 9 Division impose the 200-percent risk penalty that is 10 authorized by statute and Division Rule 35 against those 11 interest owners that do not voluntarily participate in this well? 12 13 Yes, we do. Α. Is McElvain Exhibit Number 3 an affidavit with 14 0. attached letters giving notice of this hearing? 15 16 Α. Yes. And you have received return cards from the 17 Q. 18 parties except for Mr. Phillips; is that correct? 19 Α. Yes, it is. 20 And in fact, this has two of the addresses that Q. you attempted to contact Mr. Phillips at? 21 22 Α. That's correct. 23 All right. And this is the same Mr. Phillips Q. 24 that you testified about previously? 25 Α. Yes, it is.

1	Q. And is McElvain Exhibit Number 4 an affidavit of
2	publication in the Rio Grande Sun, which is a weekly
3	newspaper of general circulation in Rio Arriba County?
4	A. Yes.
5	Q. Were McElvain Exhibits 1 through 4 prepared by
6	you or compiled under your direction and supervision?
7	A. Yes, they were.
8	MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, at this time I
9	would move the admission into evidence of McElvain Exhibits
10	1 through 4.
11	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: All right, help me out in
12	finding Exhibit Number 4 here.
13	MR. FELDEWERT: Exhibit Number 4 should be last
14	in your packet. It's an affidavit of publication.
15	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay, yeah. Exhibits 1
16	through 4 will be admitted into evidence.
17	MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, that concludes my
18	examination of this witness.
19	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Do you have any questions?
20	MS. MacQUESTEN: No questions, thank you.
21	EXAMINATION
22	BY EXAMINER EZEANYIM:
23	Q. Okay. Ms. Greer, in looking at the notice
24	requirements and I know you have an affidavit about
25	notice requirements, the newspaper advertisement do you

have it or -- I don't have it in my file. I need to look 1 2 at that newspaper advertisement. MR. FELDEWERT: That would be Exhibit Number 4. 3 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Oh, okay, it's attached, 4 5 yeah. 6 MR. FELDEWERT: It's for the Rio Grande Sun, which is a weekly newspaper of general circulation in Rio 7 Arriba County. 8 (By Examiner Ezeanyim) Okay. Oh, yeah, that's 9 Q. the newspaper, okay. 10 You talked about making a good faith effort in 11 getting all the interest owners to participate --12 13 Α. Yes. -- phone calls -- Do you have something to show 14 me that you did all those that you stated in your 15 testimony? You know, you said that you sent a letter and 16 it came back, or you made a call. Is there any way you can 17 show me that you did all those? 18 Yes, I have it in my files that are sitting back 19 at the chair there. 20 21 Q. Okay, I would like to have those. 22 A. Okay. MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, we can certainly 23 supplement the record. 24 (By Examiner Ezeanyim) And as you said, these 25 Q.

three interest owners have refused to join in the drilling 1 2 of this well, right? 3 A. Correct. Have you obtained an APD for this well? 4 Q. 5 Yes, we have. Α. And do you have an API number? 6 Q. 7 I don't have it with me, but we do have one, yes. Α. Okay. Maybe you can give us that, you know. 8 Q. 9 Do you have an idea when you wish to spud this 10 well? As quickly as we can. 11 A. What does that mean? 12 Q. They're trying to get a rig right now out there 13 Α. to start drilling this well. We've had problems getting 14 rigs, but I think -- hopefully, we would like to try and 15 drill it in about a week. 16 In a week? 17 Q. To drill -- yes. 18 Α. Well, are you saying that you have some lease 19 Q. issues, leases expiring or something, or just you have the 20 rig? 21 We have the rig. We've been trying for a year to 22 Α. get a rig, so now that we have it we can't let it disappear 23 or it could be another year. 24

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Q.

And as I understand, you want McElvain to be

1	definitely the operator of the well?
2	A. Yes.
3	Q. And when I look at this, what is the primary
4	objective of this well? Do you know?
5	A. Blanco-Mesaverde.
6	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: All right, that's all I have
7	for this witness.
8	MR. FELDEWERT: That concludes our presentation.
9	Thank you, Mr. Examiner, and I will supplement the record
10	with the other
11	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: So then Case Number 13,340
12	will be taken under advisement.

14	8:35 a.m.)
