Maralo is in receipt of a faxed copy of your letter dated September 9, 2004.

As an accommodation and an attempt to minimize the risk of injury or damage, Maralo is agreeable to assist the State of New Mexico by supplying a water truck to attempt to kill the flow of gas to the surface from the captioned well.

Please understand, however, that this is not a waiver of any of our legal rights. This is not and never has been our wellbore and we have never claimed responsibility for this well. We believe further action on this well is the responsibility of the State of New Mexico and would suggest that the State take immediate action.

Please realize further that we cannot be responsible for any cost incurred by the State in connection with this well.
