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1 WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at  
2 8:15 a.m.:

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5 EXAMINER STOGNER: This hearing will come to  
6 order. Please note today's date, August 19th, 2004. We're  
7 here to consider Docket Number 23-04.

8 We'll go through the continuances and dismissals.

9 On the first page on the top, Case 13,295, that  
10 case is dismissed.

11 Case 13,322, this is the Application of  
12 Richardson Operating Company to amend Division Order Number  
13 R-10,656-A for compulsory pooling and an unorthodox coal  
14 gas well location, San Juan County, New Mexico; this case  
15 will be readvertised and continued to September 2nd.

16 Please note the next one, 13,315. On the docket,  
17 it is 13,115. That should be 13,315, which is the  
18 Application of Apache Corporation for compulsory pooling,  
19 Lea County, New Mexico. This case, 133,15, will be  
20 continued to September 2nd.

21 Down at the bottom, Case 13,323, Application of  
22 OXY USA WTP LP for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New  
23 Mexico. This case will be continued to September the  
24 second.

25 Second page, middle one, Case Number 13,325.

1 This is in the matter of the Application of Myco  
2 Industries, Inc., for compulsory pooling and a nonstandard  
3 Atoka gas spacing unit, Eddy County, New Mexico. This case  
4 will be continued to September 2nd.

5 On the bottom, Case 13,326, Application of  
6 Mewbourne Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County,  
7 New Mexico. This case will be continued to September the  
8 16th.

9 Skipping over page 3 to page 4, down toward the  
10 bottom, Case 13,320. This is the Application of Platinum  
11 Exploration, Inc., for approval of a saltwater disposal  
12 well, Lea County, New Mexico. This case will be continued  
13 to September the 2nd.

14 Down at the bottom, Case 13,304, Application of  
15 JTD Resources, LLC, for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New  
16 Mexico. This case will also be continued to September the  
17 2nd.

18 Page 5, last page, Case 13,229. This is the  
19 Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for an  
20 unorthodox gas well location, an exception to Division Rule  
21 104.C.(2).(b) and a retroactive approval date for a well in  
22 Chaves County, New Mexico. This case will be continued to  
23 September the 16th.

24 Are there any other continuances and/or  
25 dismissals? Mr. Bruce?

1 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on page 3 --

2 EXAMINER STOGNER: Page 3.

3 MR. BRUCE: -- the first case, 13,316, we request  
4 that that case be dismissed.

5 EXAMINER STOGNER: Case 13,316, that's the  
6 Application of Murchison Oil and Gas, Inc., for compulsory  
7 pooling --

8 MR. BRUCE: Yes.

9 EXAMINER STOGNER: -- is hereby dismissed.

10 MR. BRUCE: The next case, 13,317, also a  
11 Murchison case, request that that be continued to September  
12 2.

13 EXAMINER STOGNER: Case 13,317 will be continued  
14 to September the 2nd of 2004.

15 MR. BRUCE: On page 4 --

16 EXAMINER STOGNER: Page 4.

17 MR. BRUCE: -- the first two cases, 13,328 and  
18 13,329, both Mewbourne Oil Company cases, request that  
19 those be continued to September 16th.

20 EXAMINER STOGNER: Cases 13,328 and 13,329 will  
21 both be continued to September the 16th, 2004.

22 Any others?

23 MR. BRUCE: The next one, 13,330, another  
24 Mewbourne Case, ask that that be continued to September 2.

25 EXAMINER STOGNER: Case 13,330 will be continued

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
1 to September 2nd, 2004.
