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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 8:18 a.m.:

EXAMINER STOGNER: This hearing will come to order. Please note today's date, October 21st, 2004, to consider Docket Number 29-04. I'm Michael Stogner, appointed Hearing Examiner for today's cases.

We'll go through the continuances and dismissals first.

On the first page, Case Number 13,357, this is the Application of Matrix New Mexico Holdings, L.L.C., for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico, this case will be continued to November 4th.

The next one, Case 13,358, this is the

Application of RB Operating Company for two unorthodox oil

well locations and simultaneous dedication, Lea County, New

Mexico. This case will also be continued to November 4th.

On the second page, Case Number 13,326, this is the Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. This case will be dismissed.

On the third page, Case 13,361, this is the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a compliance order for a particular well in Lea County in Lea County, New Mexico. This case will be continued to November 4th.

The next one, 13,362, this is the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, also for a compliance order for certain wells in Lea County, New Mexico. This case will also be continued to November the 4th.

The last one, Case 13,363, this is the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order requiring Greka AM, Inc., to bring six wells into compliance with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Rules and Regulations and also authorizing the Division to plug certain wells and to forfeit the applicable security and in default of compliance by a certain operator in Lea County, New Mexico. This case will be continued to November 18th.

Any other continuances and dismissals?

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, on page 2, the Samson Resources Company case, request -- the parties have come to terms but the final papers haven't been signed. Request that it be continued for two weeks, at which time I expect to dismiss it.

MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir.

EXAMINER STOGNER: Case 13,352 will be continued to November the 4th.
