



Re: Application of Matrix New Mexico Holdings, LLC for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Matrix New Mexico Holdings, LLC has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking the compulsory pooling of certain spacing and proration units in the E/2 of Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said units will be dedicated to Matrix New Mexico Holdings, LLC's Townsend Well No. 1-A which it proposes to drill at a standard gas well location in the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 10 to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation.

This application has been continued and set for hearing before a Division Examiner on November 4, 2004. The hearing will be held in Porter Hall in the Division's Santa Fe offices. You are not required to attend this hearing, but as an owner of an interest that may be affected by this application, you may appear and present testimony. Failure to appear at that time and become a party of record will preclude you from challenging the matter at a later date.

Parties appearing in cases are required by Division Rule 1208.B to file a Pre-Hearing Statement with the Oil Conservation Division's Santa Fe office located at 1220 South Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505, three days in advance of a scheduled hearing. This statement must include: the names of the parties and their attorneys; a concise statement of the case; the names of all witnesses the party will call to testify at the hearing; the approximate time the party will need to present its case; and identification of any procedural matters that are to be resolved prior to the hearing.

Application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division of Matrix New Mexico Holdings, LLC, for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the bottom of the Wolfcamp formation under the following acreage in Section 10, Township 13 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in the following manner: The E/2 of said Section 10 to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for all pools formations spaced on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent; The NE/4 of said Section 10 to form a standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit for all pools and formations spaced on 160-acres within that vertical extent; the E/2 NE/4 of said Section 10 to form a standard 80-acre spacing and proration unit for all pools and formations spaced on 80-acres within that vertical extent, including, but not necessarily limited to, the East Stallion-Devonian Oil Pool; and the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 10 to form a standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit for all pools and formations spaced on 40-acres within that vertical extent, including, but not necessarily limited to,

the Bronco-Mississippian Oil Pool; the Bronco-Siluro Devonian Oil Pool; and the Bronco-Wolfcamp Oil Pool. Applicant proposes to dedicate these pooled units to its proposed Townsend #1-A Well, to be drilled at a standard gas well location in the NE/4 NE/4 of said Section 10. Also to be considered will the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Matrix New Mexico Operating Company, LLC as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. 
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
