EXAMINER STOGNER: This hearing will come to order. Please make a note, today's date December 2nd, 2004, Docket Number 33-04. I'm Michael Stogner, appointed Hearing Officer for today's cases.

We'll go through the continuances and dismissals first.

Let's go to the second page. Case Number 13,365, Nadel and Gussman Permian, L.L.C., for compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Case Number 13,365 will be continued to December 16th.

The next one, Case 13,389, Application of Nadel and Gussman Permian, L.L.C., for compulsory pooling, Chaves County, New Mexico. This case will also be continued to December 16th.

The next one down, Case 13,352, this is the Application of Samson Resources Company for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. This case will also be continued until the 16th.

Let's go to page 3. On top of the page, Case 13,390, Application of Pride Energy Company for an unorthodox location and for simultaneous dedication, Lea County, New Mexico. This case will be dismissed.

Next case, 13,379, and also the one after that,
13,380, both of these cases are for Chi Energy, Inc., both
of them are for compulsory pooling. 13,379 is in Eddy
County, 13,380 is also in Eddy County. Both of these cases
are also continued to December the 16th. Please make a
note that these cases, I believe, were heard two weeks ago;
is that correct, Mr. Bruce?

MR. BRUCE: That's correct, and there need to be some additional -- I had to get the advertisement in, and I still haven't gotten the --

EXAMINER STOGNER: All righty. Down at the bottom, 13,387, Latigo Petroleum, Inc., for a nonstandard gas spacing and proration unit and for an unorthodox gas well location in Lea County, New Mexico. I'm not sure which pool that's in, but this case is also continued to December the 16th.

Any other continuances or dismissals at this time?

There being none, just to let you know what will be happening today, I'll call the Yates case -- that will be the first one -- and then we will move to the second page down at the bottom and take 13,359 out of sequence, and then we will take the Bass and Devon Energy Production cases in the potash area, consolidate them or hear at one time, or we'll discuss that at that time.
