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WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 8:30 a.m.: 2 EXAMINER CATANACH: At this time I'll call Case 3 13,379, the Application of Chi Energy, Inc., for compulsory 4 pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. 5 Call for appearances. 6 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, 7 representing the Applicant. I have one witness. 8 9 EXAMINER CATANACH: Any other appearances? 10 Okay. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, if the record could 11 12 reflect, the witness is Mr. Qualls who was previously sworn 13 in and qualified. 14 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, Mr. Bruce, the record shall reflect that. 15 JOHN W. QUALLS, 16 the witness herein, having been previously duly sworn upon 17 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: 18 DIRECT EXAMINATION 19 BY MR. BRUCE: 20 Mr. Qualls, could you identify Exhibit 1 for the 21 Q. 22 Examiner and briefly describe what Chi seeks in this case? 23 Α. Exhibit 1 is a land map --24 EXAMINER CATANACH: Excuse me, excuse me, I don't 25 have any exhibits in this case.

That's probably because I didn't give 1 MR. BRUCE: 2 them to you. EXAMINER CATANACH: Could speed things up. 3 MR. BRUCE: They all look the same. 4 (By Mr. Bruce) Mr. Qualls, can you identify 5 Q. Exhibit 1? 6 Exhibit 1 is a land map showing the south half of 7 A. Section 29, 22 South, 27, which will be where the location 8 of the Rogers Number 1 will be. 9 10 Q. What is the footage location of the Rogers Number 11 1? 12 A. The Rogers Number 1 is going to be 990 from the east line, 990 from the south line. 13 Okay, this well will be drilled to a depth 14 Q. sufficient to test the Morrow formation? 15 Yes, sir. Α. 16 And that's one of the primary zones in the well? 17 Q. Yes, sir. 18 A. In this case you're seeking to force pool 320-19 Q. acre units; is that correct? 20 21 Α. Yes. Are you also seeking to force pool the southeast 22 quarter for 160-acre units, and the southeast quarter 23 southeast quarter -- or --24 25 A. Yes.

1	Q. Southeast quarter for 160-acre units, excuse me.
2	Who is the only party you're seeking to pool at
3	this time?
4	A. The only person we can't find is Harry M. White,
5	who owns 40 net acres there in the southeast quarter, and
6	the last known address for him was in Fort Lauderdale,
7	Florida.
8	Q. Okay. Now, Exhibit 2 is a copy of a letter you
9	sent to Mr. White; is that correct?
10	A. Yes.
11	Q. And that was returned?
12	A. Yes.
13	Q. He owns what, 40 net acres in the southeast
14	quarter
15	A. Yes.
16	Q for a 1/8 working interest in the well?
17	A. Yes, sir.
18	Q. Now, what records were searched to locate Mr.
19	White?
20	A. We searched the records of Eddy County and
21	Carlsbad. We also searched the Internet and made numerous
22	attempts to find any record of anything that had been
23	that Harry White would actually have an address on. This
24	is the last address I could find. I believe it was 1976,
25	is the last time he was located.

Okay, so this address is almost 30 years old? 1 Q. 2 Α. Yes. In your opinion, has Chi made a good-faith effort 3 Q. to locate Mr. White? 4 Yes, sir. 5 Α. What is Exhibit 3, Mr. Qualls? 6 Q. Exhibit 3 is an AFE showing the drilling and 7 completion costs of the well, which will be \$1,393,975, 8 total well cost. 9 And is this cost in line with the cost of other 10 Q. 11 wells drilled to this depth in this area of Eddy County? 12 A. Yes, sir. 13 Q. Does Chi Energy request again that this well be 14 operated by Chi Operating, Inc.? Α. Yes, sir. 15 Q. And what overhead rates do you request for Chi 16 Operating, Inc.? 17 \$6000 for drilling and \$600 for producing. 18 And are these cost in line with the costs of the 19 overhead rates of other operators in this area? 20 Yes, sir. 21 Α. Do you request that the overhead rates be 22 adjusted periodically as provided by the COPAS accounting 23 procedure? 24 A. Yes, sir. 25

1 Q. Does Chi request the maximum cost-plus-200-2 percent risk penalty be assessed against any nonconsenting 3 interest owner? Α. Yes. 4 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner Exhibit 4 is simply the 5 affidavit of notice, mailing notice, to Mr. White. I 6 7 published an ad in the paper, and that has not been 8 returned to me yet, against Mr. White's interest. I would ask perhaps just continue the case for two weeks so that 9 10 the ad can be placed in the record of this matter. 11 EXAMINER CATANACH: That would be fine, Mr. 12 Bruce, except I think we have another mistake in the 13 quarter quarter section in this case. If I understand 14 correctly, the well is going to be drilled in the southeast 15 southeast; is that correct? It looks like the ad says 16 northeast southeast. 17 THE WITNESS: I can check on the exact location 18 of that. I may have that wrong again. Yeah. Mr. Examiner, if that's MR. BRUCE: 19 20 correct then it would have to be continued for four weeks. 21 EXAMINER CATANACH: All right, well, you get back 22 to me on the location, but for now we'll just continue it 23 for four weeks. 24 MR. BRUCE: Okay. 25 Q. (By Mr. Bruce) Were Exhibits 1 through 4

1 prepared by you or compiled from company business records, 2 Mr. Qualls? 3 A. Yes, sir. And in your opinion is the granting of Chi's 4 Q. Application in the interests of conservation and the 5 prevention of waste? 6 7 A. Yes. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I'd move the admission 8 9 of Chi Exhibits 1 through 4. 10 EXAMINER CATANACH: Chi's Exhibits 1 through 4 will be admitted. 11 12 **EXAMINATION** BY EXAMINER CATANACH: 13 14 Q. Mr. Qualls, what is the percentage of interest 15 owned by Mr. White? 16 Α. He owns 12 1/2 percent of the well. 12 1/2 percent. 17 Q. 40 net mineral acre. 18 Α. 19 And the last known address that you've got for 20 him was from where? 21 Α. I found a deed into him, I believe it was 1976, 22 in the Eddy County records. It listed his address in Fort Lauderdale, Florida. And we searched the Internet and I've 23 24 had a landman try to find him, and we just cannot locate 25 him, or any of his heirs.

EXAMINER CATANACH: I'm not sure what you put in 1 2 your ad, but you may need to redo the newspaper advertisement as well. 3 MR. BRUCE: Yeah, it should have been -- I got a 4 5 call from the newspaper, they had mailed my -- the affidavits to P.O. Box 2043, which is my phone number 6 extension, so... They haven't been coming promptly, so... 7 EXAMINER CATANACH: All right. Okay, anything 8 further in this case? 9 MR. BRUCE: No, sir. 10 EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, this case will be then 11 continued to the December 16th hearing. 12 (Off the record at 8:39 a.m.) 13 14 (The following proceedings had at 9:55 a.m.:) EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, at this time I'll call 15 the hearing back to order. And before we proceed with the 16 next case, I believe we have an additional statement in 17 18 Case Number 13,379. MR. BRUCE: Yes, Mr. Examiner, the Application of 19 20 Chi Energy. The correct well location is given in the 21 advertisement. It's in the northeast quarter of the 22 southeast quarter of the section. The approximate footage is 1830 from the south line and 660 from the east line. 23 As a result, the case only needs to be continued 24 for two weeks, rather than four. 25
