CASE 13337: APPLICATION OF THE NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION, THROUGH THE SUPERVISOR OF DISTRICT I, FOR AN ORDER REQUIRING CARBON ENERGY INC. AND CARBON ENERGY TO BRING WELLS INTO COMPLIANCE WITH 19.15.4.201 NMAC, AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION TO PLUG SAID WELLS AND ORDERING A FORFEITURE OF THE APPLICABLE FINANCIAL ASSURANCES; LEACOUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

You are hereby notified that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division has filed the above-captioned Application seeking an order requiring you to bring the Shell State #1 well, API #30-025-26637, and the Aztec 28 State #3 well, API 30-025-04361 into compliance with Division rules by plugging and abandoning the wells, securing temporary abandonment status for the wells, or returning the wells to a Division-approved beneficial use. A copy of the Application is enclosed.

"Carbon Energy" posted a \$10,000 single well cash bond with cash collateral deposited with the First Interstate Bank of Lea County, in account number 65447, to secure its obligation to plug and abandon the Shell State #1 well, API #30-025-26637, in compliance with Division rules. That security will be forfeited if an order is entered as requested in the attached application and that well is not brought into compliance with Division rules by the date set by the order.
