WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 8:48 a.m.: EXAMINER CATANACH: Call Case 13,382, the 3 Application of Chi Energy, Inc., for compulsory pooling, 4 Eddy County, New Mexico. 5 Call for appearances. 6 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe 7 8 representing the Applicant. I have one witness. 9 EXAMINER CATANACH: Any additional appearances? 10 There being none, let the record show that Mr. 11 Qualls has been previously sworn in and testified as an expert landman. 12 JOHN W. QUALLS, 13 the witness herein, having been previously duly sworn upon 14 15 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: DIRECT EXAMINATION 16 BY MR. BRUCE: 17 Mr. Qualls, could you identify Exhibit 1 for the 18 Q. Examiner and briefly describe what Chi seeks in this case? 19 Exhibit 1 is a land map showing the east half of 20 Α. Section 14, 19 South, 27 East, which would be the proration 21 unit for the Foot Joy Number 1. 22 23 What is the name of the proposed well? Q. The Foot Joy State Com Number 1. 24 Α. 25 And what quarter quarter section is this located Q.

2	A. It's 990 from the north, 660 from the east.		
3	Q. Okay.		
4	A. Northeast northeast.		
5	Q. So do you also request, besides the force pooling		
6	of 320 acre units, the force pooling of the northeast		
7	quarter and of the northeast northeast?		
8	A. Yes, sir.		
9	Q. What is the primary zone of interest in this		
10	well?		
11	A. It will be a Morrow well.		
12	Q. Could you identify Exhibit 2 for the Examiner and		
13	identify the parties that Chi Energy seeks to force pool

15	A. Exhibit 2 lists the letters that I sent to Monte

19	A. I have talked with Monte Mount and I have talked		
20	with Shirley Choate of Redfern Enterprises, Inc. I have		
21	not talked with Thomas Lett of I&L Development.		
22	Q. Okay, have you received any written response to		
23	these letters?		
24	A. No.

2	A. Monte Mount called me on Monday, and he'd been on		
3	vacation for a month. He's an 83-year-old man living in		
4	Lubbock, Texas, and said that he would like to do		
5	something. I said we were going to go ahead with the		
6	hearing because I couldn't have got the paperwork to him		
7	and got the stuff back, but we will get a deal from him.		
8	Q. Okay, and if you do reach an agreement with Mr.		
9	Mount, or any of the other interest owners, will you so		
10	notify the Division?		
11	A. Yes, sir.		
12	Q. In your opinion, has Chi Energy made a good-faith		
13	effort to obtain the voluntary joinder of the interest		
14	owners in the well?		
15	A. Yes.		
16	Q. What is Exhibit 3, Mr. Qualls?		
17	A. Exhibit 3 is an AFE showing the drilling and cost		
18	for the well, \$1,493,501.

22	A. That will be approximately 11,000 feet.

Development would own .80 percent of the well, and Redfern 3 Enterprises, Inc., would own 3.25 percent of the well. 4 Were Exhibits 1 through 4 prepared by you or 5 Q. under your supervision? 6 7 Α. Yes. And in your opinion is the granting of this Q. 8 Application in the interests of conservation and the 9 prevention of waste? 10 Α. Yes. 11 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I'd move the admission 12 of Exhibits 1 through 4. 13 EXAMINER CATANACH: Exhibits 1 through 4 will be 14 15 admitted. EXAMINATION 16 BY EXAMINER CATANACH: 17 Mr. Qualls, I&L, have you not been able to get 18 Q. ahold of them? 19 20 Α. I called and left a message for Thomas Lett, and he never returned my phone call. 21 22 **Q**. But you're fairly sure that's the right address for those --23 Α. Yes. 24 25 And the other interest, Redfern, do you Q.

1 anticipate them doing anything? 2 Α. Shirley Choate said that they would do something, but she has not gotten back in touch with me. It's been 3 probably three weeks since I talked to her. 4 These well costs appear to be a little higher 5 Q. than the previous case. Is there a reason for that? 6 Casing has gone up. When we AFE'd this one, the 7 Α. price of casing had gone up, and that's one reason it's a 8 9 little bit higher. Okay, I have nothing further. 10 EXAMINER CATANACH: MR.
