WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:03 a.m.: CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Okay, we'll go ahead and 3 get started this morning. It's shortly after 9:00 a.m. on 4 May 15th, 2003. This is a meeting of the Oil Conservation 5 Commission. We're in Porter Hall, in Santa Fe, New Mexico. 6 I'm Lori Wrotenbery, I serve as Chair of the 7 Commission. 8 To my right is Jami Bailey, who represents Land 9 Commissioner Patrick Lyons on the Commission. 10 And to my left is Dr. Robert Lee, who serves as 11 the appointee to the Commission of the Secretary of the 12 13 Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department. To my far right is Florene Davidson, the 14 15 Commission's secretary. To Dr. Lee's left, Steven Ross, the Commission's 16 legal counsel. 17 And then Steve Brenner will be recording these 18 19 proceedings for us here today. We've got a number of items, Commissioners, that 20 21 I think are ready for final action this morning, so we'll 22 go through those pretty quickly here at the outset. 23 First are the minutes of the April 17th, 2003, Commission Hearing. Have you had a chance to review those 24 minutes? 25

1 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move we adopt them. 2 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. 3 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 4 5 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. COMMISSIONER LEE: 6 Aye. 7 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. And I'll sign on behalf of the Commission. 8 9 10 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Okay, in addition we have a 11 12 draft final order in Case Number 12,792. This is the 13 Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order requiring Kelly H. Baxter to properly plug seven 14 15 wells, imposing civil penalties in the event of failure to 16 comply, authorizing the Division to plug said wells in 17 default of compliance by Kelly H. Baxter or his surety, and 18 ordering forfeiture of applicable plugging bond, in Lea 19 County, New Mexico. Commissioners, have you had a chance to review 20 the draft order? 21 22 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move 23 that we sign it. 24 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 25

1 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 2 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye. 3 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. * * * 4 5 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: We also have a draft order 6 7 in Case Number 12,905. This is the Application of 8 Pronghorn Management Corporation for approval of a 9 saltwater disposal well in Lea County, New Mexico. 10 Again, have you had a chance to review this order? 11 12 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move 13 that we sign it. 14 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. 15 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 16 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 17 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye. 18 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. 19 * * 20 21 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: In Case Number 12,862 we 22 have a draft order in the matter of the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order requiring 23 24 N. Dale Nichols to bring eight wells into compliance with 25 Rule 201.B and assessing appropriate civil penalties, in

Chaves County, New Mexico. 1 Have you had a chance to review this draft, 2 Commissioners? 3 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move we 4 5 sign it. COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. 6 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 7 8 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. 9 COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye. CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. 10 * 11 12 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Okay, and then the last two 13 draft orders we have today were orders in the rule-making 14 matters that we heard at the last Commission meeting. 15 First is Case 13,029, the Application of the Oil 16 17 Conservation Division to amend Rule 1107 concerning applications for multiple completions, Form C-107. 18 Again, have you had a chance to review the draft 19 order? 20 21 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move that we sign it. 22 23 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. 24 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 25 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye.

COMMISSIONER LEE: Aye. 1 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. 2 3 4 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: And the other rule-making 5 order is in Case Number 13,030, the Application of the Oil 6 Conservation Division to amend Rule 1209 concerning 7 8 continuance of a hearing without new service. And this is the last time I'll ask you this 9 today. Have you had a chance to review this draft order? 10 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Yes, I have, and I move 11 12 that we sign it. 13 COMMISSIONER LEE: Second. CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: All in favor say aye. 14 15 COMMISSIONER BAILEY: Aye. COMMISSIONER LEE: 16 Aye. 17 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Aye. 18 * * 19 20 CHAIRMAN WROTENBERY: Thank you, Florene. And we still have in the works a draft order in 21 22 the consolidated Cases 12,816, 12,841, 12,859 and 12,860. 23 These were Applications of TMBR/Sharp Drilling, Inc.; Ocean Energy, Inc.; and David H. Arrington, Inc., for compulsory 24 pooling in Lea County, New Mexico. And that order should 25
