Re: *Administrative application (administrative application reference No. pSEM0-428147329) for an exception to the well location provisions of the rules and regulations governing the South Knowles-Devonian Pool (36480) for Platinum Exploration Inc.'s ("Platinum") existing Lawrence "19" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-025-32737) to be re-completed utilizing horizontal drilling techniques such that the resulting drainhole's producing area will extend beyond the standard setback requirements from the outer boundary of the proposed project area, being a standard 80-acre lay-down oil spacing and proration unit, comprising the N/2 NW/4 of Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 39 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.*

Dear Mr. Kuykendall:

As I stated in my letter to you dated October 28, 2004, the Division had received the above-described administrative application on October 7, 2004. I received Ms. Dorothea Logan's reply to this letter on November 12, 2004; however, on November 10, 2004 I received correspondence from Ms. Claudette Hill Culp of Lubbock, Texas objecting to Platinum's administrative application. Ms. Culp's letter was dated October 12, 2004; the corresponding envelope shows a postmark of October 22, 2004. She used an old outdated address for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division that was on your letter to her on October 5, 2004, "2040 South Pacheco." Rule 104.F (4) provides for a 20-day waiting period from the date the Division receives the application. This would have the 20-day waiting period for Platinum's application ending on October 27, 2004. The Division will honor Ms. Culp's objection since: (i) your application was not completed until November 12, 2004; and (ii) you somehow provided the wrong address to the parties notified of this application while sending the original filing to the correct address which resulted in Ms. Culp's delay.

This application will therefore be set for hearing before a Division Hearing Examiner on the next available docket scheduled for December 16, 2004. In order to expatiate this matter I have prepared the following advertisement in this matter:

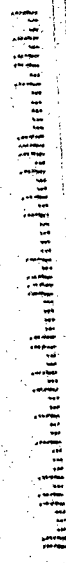



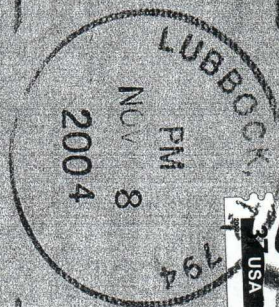
