# Affidavit of Dorothy Phillips

Dorothy Phillips, being first duly sworn on oath, states as follows:

1. I have been employed as the bond administrator at the Santa Fe, New Mexico office of the Oil Conservation Division ("OCD") for the past four years.

2. My duties include maintaining records of financial assurance documents filed by operators pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-14.

3. I have reviewed OCD's financial assurance records to determine if financial assurance documents were filed for the following wells:

Reno Federal #001, API 30-005-00548, UL L, Sec. 3, 15S, 31E, Chaves Co. Reno Federal #002, API 30-005-10151, UL M, Sec. 3, 15S, 31E, Chaves Co. Reno Federal #003, API 30-005-10152, UL K, Sec. 3, 15S, 31E, Chaves Co. Reno Federal #004, API 30-005-10153, UL N, Sec. 3, 15S, 31E, Chaves Co.

4. OCD's electronic permitting database, "E-Permitting," identifies the wells associated with a particular operator that have not been plugged. Attachment "A" to this affidavit is a printout of the E-Permitting screen showing RW Oil Company as the operator of the wells identified in paragraph 3 of this affidavit. According to OCD's electronic permitting database, RW Oil Company does not have any unplugged wells other than the four wells identified in paragraph 3 of this affidavit.

Before the OCD Case 13412 OCD Ex. 3 5. ONGARD (oil and natural gas administration and revenue data base) maintains data on the financial assurances posted by operators. Attachment "B" to this affidavit is a printout of the ONGARD screen showing that RW Oil Company posted a \$50,000 blanket bond, No. BO4841, issued by the Underwriters Indemnity Company.

6. A copy of bond BO4841 is Attachment "C" to this affidavit. The bond was approved by the OCD on February 20, 1995. The principal on the face of the bond is "Tommy L. Willyard, Jr. dba RW Oil Company." The principal signed the bond "Tommy L. Willyard dba R W Oil Co."

7. OCD records show no amendments or riders to bond number BO4841, and according to OCD records, that bond remains in effect.

8. Attachment "D" to this affidavit is a letter from Jean E. Crain, dated September 28, 1994, requesting release of a bond for "Willis dba RW Oil Company" on the basis that the leases were sold to "Tommy L. Willyard, Jr. dba RW Oil Company,"and that Mr. Willyard had posted a bond for the wells.

WHEREAS, The above principal has heretofore or may hereafter enter into oil and gas leases, or carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) gas leases, or helium gas leases or brine mineral leases with the State of New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, The above principal has heretofore or may hereafter enter into oil and gas leases, or carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) gas leases, or helium gas leases or brine mineral leases on lands patented by the United States<sup>2</sup> of America to private individuals, and on lands otherwise owned by private individuals; and

WHEREAS, The above principal, individually, or in association with one or more other parties, has commenced or may commence the drilling of wells to prospect for and produce oil or gas, or carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) gas or helium gas, or does own or may acquire, own or operate such well, or such wells started by others on land embraced in said State oil and gas leases or brine minerals, or carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) gas leases, or helium gas leases or brine mineral leases, and on land patented by the United States of America to private individuals, and on land otherwise owned by private individuals, the identification and location of said well being expressly waived by both principal and surety hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, If the above bounden principal and surety or either of them or their successors or assigns, or any of them, shall plug all of said wells when dry or when abandoned in accordance with the rules, regulations, and orders of the Oil Conservation Division of New Mexico in such way as to confine the oil, gas, brine and water in the strata in which they are found, and to prevent them from escaping into other strata;

THEN, THEREFORE, This obligation shall be null and void; otherwise and in default of complete compliance with any and all of said obligations, the same shall remain in full force and effect.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That thirty (30) days after receipt by the Oil Conservation Division of New Mexico of written notice of cancellation from the surety, the obligation of the surety hereunder shall terminate as to property or wells acquired, drilled, or started after said thirty (30) day period but shall continue in effect, notwithstanding said notice, as to property or wells theretofore acquired, drilled or started.


