APPLICATION

YATES PETROLEUM CORPORATION ("Yates"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving its Leanin Lagederal Exploratory Unit and in support of this application states:

1. The proposed Unit Area consists of 2640 acres, more or less, of Federal lands, situated in Chaves County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

Township 15 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 3: S2 SE4
Section 8: All
Section 9: All
Section 10: All

Section 17: All

2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

- 3. The Applicant, Yates Petroleum Corporation, is designated as Unit Operator in said Unit Agreement and all oil and gas in the all formations are unitized.
- 4. The proposed Unit Area covers all, or substantially all, of the geological structures or anomaly from the top of the Queen formation to the base of the Chester Lime at approximately 10,300 feet.

5. Said Unit Agreement and the unitized operation and management of the Unit Area will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste, and that it will protect the correlative rights of all parties concerned.

WHEREFORE, Yates Petroleum Corporation requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on January 6, 2005, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Leanin L Federal Exploratory Unit be approved.
