John H.N. Smith, Esq., Santa Fe, New Mexico, is one of the attorneys of record for Cimarex Energy Co. ("Cimarex"). Cimarex Energy Co. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a non-standard oil spacing and production unit ("Unit") in the Apache County location comprised of the E/2E/4 of Section 18 of Township 16 North, Range 12 East, N.M.P.M. Chave County, New Mexico, for horizontal oil and gas wells. The proposed spacing and production unit ("Unit") and proposed horizontal well interests in the proposed well completion underlying the non-standard Unit. The Unit to be dedicated to the FracNet-18 Fed. Com. Well No. 4, a horizontal well, to be drilled at a surface location 375 feet from the south line and 375 feet from the east line, with a terminus 375 feet from the north line and 375 feet from the east line of Section 18. Also to be considered will be the cost of mining and connecting to the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, between the owner, operating costs and charges for supervision, decommissioning, and cleanup of the well, and the appropriate allocation of the well, and a 20% share of the net profit involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is subject to be heard by the Oil Conservation Division January 21<sup>st</sup> 2009 at the Division's Offices at 1220 South Alvarado Street, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interested party, you are hereby notified that you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the proceedings, and to file a written protest with you from contesting this matter at a later date. The protest should be addressed to James Bruce, P.O. Box 1165, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. The well interests located approximately 14-1/2 miles north-northeast of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
