Steubben, or their successors-in-interest: Nadel and Gussman Permian, L.L.C. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S1/2 of Section 32, Township 22 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is dedicated to the Brutus Well No. 1, located in the SW1/4SW1/4 of the section, and the Grizzly Well No. 1; located in the NE1/4SE1/4 of the section. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells. This matter will be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, February 17, 2005 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As interest owners in the well unit, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The units are located approximately 4 miles north-northwest of Loving, New Mexico.
