#### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

#### **BY THE DIVISION:**

This case came on for consideration on the Motion of COG Operating, LLC ("COG") to Re-Open Case Nos. 14682, 14683, 14684 and 14685, before Examiner David K. Brooks.

NOW, on this 5<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2011, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner,

#### FINDS THAT:

(1) Due notice has been given, and the Division has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this case.

(2) This case was heard before a Division hearing examiner on July 7, 2011. COG neither appeared at the hearing nor filed an entry of appearance or other paper in the case.

(3) On July 19, 2011, the Division issued Order No. R-13429, granting the application.

(4) On July 25, 2011, COG filed its motion to re-open this case.

(5) COG does not contend that it did not receive notice of this application or of the hearing on July 7. Instead, it asserts that it "intended to oppose the applications but by inadvertent mistake failed to do so."

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
(6) The Division concludes that this motion does not present sufficient grounds to re-open a case that has been decided by final order.
