STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

OPPONENT

COG Operating LLC ("COG") seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation underlying the S/2S/2 of Section 1, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M..

ZPZ Delaware I LLC ("ZPZ") owns 100% of the working interest in the E/2 of Section 1. Apache Corporation ("Apache") operates leases owned by ZPZ Delaware I LLC. ZPZ and Apache oppose COG's application for the following reasons:

- 1. ZPZ and Apache are preparing to develop its acreage, on a 100% basis, with the drilling of horizontal Yeso well units. COG's proposed well will interfere with these plans.
- 2. The operating agreement provided to ZPZ and Apache by COG contains certain non-standard provisions on which COG is unwilling to negotiate. Thus, COG has not made a good faith effort to obtain the voluntary joinder of ZPZ in the proposed well.
