As a land owner near the proposed site of Breitburn's injection saltwater brine well, I would like to express my concerns of the proposed application as follows:

1. Chemical contamination of the Ogalla aquifer.
2. Chemical contamination to nearby Ute Creek, part of the Canadian Watershed that feeds into Ute Dam, in Logan, N.M. and on into Texas.
3. Chemical contamination of private land and nearby State Land.
4. Chemical contamination hazards due to accidental equipment malfunction or human error caused spills.
5. Threats to the future of our agricultural and recreational livelihood and overall quality of life.
6. Responsibility for environmental damages.

What studies have been done that positively show no concern of the migration of these chemicals to the ground water or surface water? Can you provide me any predicted modeling studies that have been used in determining such injection is safe. Please provide me evidence. If you don't have the evidence how can you approve this application. Do not make a hasty decision when oil companies can commission such studies to support their actions. Don't advance their application without proof. Anything short of that would be irresponsible.

Our family homestead in Harding County prior to 1886 and have survived natural disasters, but are fearfully we could not survive a man made disaster that contaminates our precious watershed.
