Therefore, it requests that the cases be continued to the Division's May 26th docket.¹

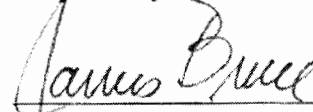

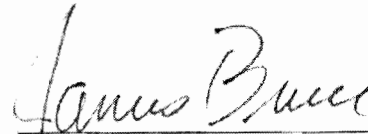
