



Case 15479: Application of Matador Production Company for a non-standard spacing and proration unit, approval of an unorthodox location, and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 240-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the W2 SE/4 of Section 22 and the W/2 E/2 of Section 27, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, Lea County, New Mexico (2) approving an unorthodox well location; and (3) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Mallon 27 Federal Com No. 2H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 27 to a standard bottom hole location in the NW/4 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 22. The completed interval is unorthodox pursuant to the Special Rules for the Lea; Bone Spring Pool (37570) because it will not remain within 150 feet from the quarter-quarter section. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Matador Production Company as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 25 miles southwest of Hobbs, New Mexico. #30788
