- 3 Number 15748, re-opened, application of -- amended
- 4 application of Matador Production Company to re-open
- 5 Case Number 15748 to amend the initial well under the
- 6 terms of Compulsory Pooling Order R-14433, Eddy County,
- 7 New Mexico.
- 8 Call for appearances.
- 9 MS. KESSLER: Mr. Examiner, Jordan Kessler
- 10 from the Santa Fe office of Holland & Hart.
- 11 EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances in
- 12 this case?
- 13 Please proceed.
- MS. KESSLER: As I mentioned, this case
- 15 will be presented by affidavit. What I've placed in
- 16 front of you is Exhibits 17 and 18.
- 17 Exhibit 17 is an affidavit from Mr. Sam
- 18 Pryor, who was the landman in the initial case, 155 --
- 19 I'm sorry -- 15748. That case requested formation of a
- 20 155.83-acre spacing and proration unit that was
- 21 comprised of the south half-south half of Section 19, in
- 22 Township 20 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, and
- 23 compulsory pooled approximately from the Bone Spring --
- 24 uncommitted interest owners in the Bone Spring Formation
- 25 and dedicated the spacing unit to the initial well,

1 which was the Stebbins 19 Fed Com 134H well. Order

- 2 R-14433 was issued back in September authorizing the
- 3 spacing unit.
- 4 Since that time, Matador has proposed to
- 5 all of the interest owners to change the initial well in
- 6 the spacing unit, so it would not be the 134H well. It
- 7 is instead going to be the 124H well, which targets the
- 8 2nd Bone Spring rather than the 3rd Bone Spring. This
- 9 is all set forth in the affidavit.
- 10 Also included in the affidavit is
- 11 Attachment A, the C-102 for the new initial well, which
- 12 is the 124H well. And Attachment B is the well-proposal
- 13 letter and AFE that went out to all of the working
- 14 interest owners under the -- both the working interest
- 15 owners and the parties pooled under the initial order.
- 16 Exhibit 18 is an affidavit from my office
- 17 with letters and also -- it's very difficult to read.
- 18 The Notice of Publication is the last page of this
- 19 exhibit, providing notice to all of the interest owners
- 20 in the spacing unit be changed for the initial well.
- 21 EXAMINER JONES: And the change in the
- 22 target?
- MS. KESSLER: And the change in the target.
- With that, Mr. Examiners, I'm happy to
- 25 answer any questions, but I would ask that Exhibits 17

1 and 18 be admitted into the record and that this case be

- 2 taken under advisement.
- 3 EXAMINER JONES: Everything okay?
- 4 EXAMINER BROOKS: Yeah. As I've often said
- 5 about affidavits, they're not -- they're hearsay, and,
- 6 therefore, they're not admissible over objection. But
- 7 this isn't a contested case, so who is going to object?
- 8 EXAMINER JONES: No one appeared in the
- 9 original case?
- 10 MS. KESSLER: Nobody appeared in the
- 11 original case.
- 12 EXAMINER JONES: And the same parties are
- 13 being pooled?
- MS. KESSLER: There is no change in who is
- 15 being pooled at all or no changes in the ownership or
- 16 interest. Simply, the change is to the initial well.
- 17 So the order currently designates 134H, and we're asking
- 18 instead that it be the 124H.
- 19 EXAMINER JONES: The 134H, is it still out
- 20 there and is it going to be drilled?
- 21 MS. KESSLER: It is still out there and
- 22 will also be drilled, if it hasn't already. But the 124
- 23 will be --
- 24 EXAMINER JONES: The initial well.
- 25 MS. KESSLER: -- the initial well.

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1	EXAMINER JONES: Okay. With that, we'll
2	take cases or Exhibits 17, 18 17 and 18
3	MS. KESSLER: Thank you.
4	EXAMINER JONES: we'll admit those two
5	cases two exhibits and take Case Number 15748,
6	re-opened, under advisement.
7	MS. KESSLER: Thank you.
8	EXAMINER JONES: Thank you very much.
9	(Matador Production Company Exhibit Numbers
10	17 and 18 are offered and admitted into
11	evidence.)
