Dear Mr. Strickler:

The submitted Juniper Resources 2018 Plans of Development (POD) for the Pinon Unit located in San Juan County, New Mexico is approved as of March 22, 2018. A POD is required to be filed yearly by the unit operator and not later than March 1 of each year. No extension of time will be granted unless an Unavoidable Delay where justified.

It is noteworthy that Juniper Resources drilled and completed two wells in 2017 and is planning to drill two wells in 2018, the Pinon Unit 303H and 304H. In addition they are planning to sidetrack the existing Pinon Unit #306H and re-frac two existing wells the Pinon Unit 305H and 307H.

The Pinon unit POD was looked at closely because it contains at least seventeen Navajo allotments and the BLM has a trust responsibility to ensure their diligent development occurs. The Pinon unit allotments and Federal leases will continue to be looked at for their required development.
