The Dugan Production Corp. 2018 Plan of Development (POD) for the West Bist Lower Gallup Unit located in San Juan County, New Mexico is approved as of March 1, 2018. A POD is required to be filed yearly and not later than March 1 of each year. No extension of time will be granted unless an Unavoidable Delay where justified. Currently the West Bisti Lower Gallup Unit contains Federal, State and a small portion of Navajo Nation minerals.

It is noteworthy that Dugan in 2018 is planning on selling the Navajo Nation portion of the unit to Navajo Nation Oil and Gas Company.
