Dear Mr. Herritt:

The Huntington Energy 2018 Plan of Development (POD) for the Atsa Unit located in San Juan County, New Mexico is <u>approved</u> as of April 19, 2018. A POD is required to be filed yearly by the unit operator and not later than March 1 of each year. No extension of time will be granted unless an unavoidable delay where justified. The unit POD is approved specifically because there is a Fruitland Coal producing well within the unit on State lands and there are plans to drill and develop the unit when a surface use agreement with the Navajo Tribe is secured.

The Atsa Unit has only Federal and State minerals but the surface is mostly owned by the Navajo Nation.
