STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT:

Applicant in Case No. 16088 seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation, comprised of the E/2 E/2 of Section 1, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and, (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Catapult Fee 23-26-1 TB 6H well, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for the well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 6 miles south of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

In Case No. 16089, Applicant seeks an order: (1) pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the standard 320-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 1, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. This proposed standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Catapult Fee Com 23 26 1 WA 5H, Catapult Fee Com 23 26 1 WXY 3H, and Catapult Fee Com 23 26 1 WXY 10H wells, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for these wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 6 miles south of Carlsbad, New Mexico.
