 have previously testified before the Division and my credentials were accepted and made part of
 the record.
- 3. I am familiar with Marathon's operations in Southeastern, New Mexico. In connection with executing this affidavit, I have review company business records that are maintained in Marathon's normal course of business which relate to Marathon's applications in Case Nos. 16088 and 16089.
- 4. Marathon proposes to drill the Catapult Fee 23-26-1 WA 5H well at least ten feet off of the center line within the E/2 of Section 6, Township 23 South, Range 26 East, NMPM,



Eddy County, New Mexico. A new draft C-102 form has been completed for the well and is attached hereto as Exhibit A. This change was made at the request of the Division.

- 5. In addition, Marathon has changed the surface locations for the Catapult Fee 23-26-1 TB 6H, Catapult Fee Com 23-26-1 WA 5H, Catapult Fee Com 23-26-1 WXY 3H, and Catapult Fee Com 23-26-1 WXY 10H wells to be located in Unit 0 of Section 36. Amended applications were filed with the Division on May 16, 2018 in Case Nos. 16088 and 16089 which reflect this change.
- 6. Changing the surface location for the Catapult Fee 23-26-1 TB 6H, Catapult Fee Com 23-26-1 WA 5H, Catapult Fee Com 23-26-1 WXY 3H, and Catapult Fee Com 23-26-1 WXY 10H wells did not result in any changes to the cost estimates provided in Marathon's AFEs provided to working interest owners on February 16, 2018.
- 7. Marathon has also received confirmation from Raymond Podany at the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division that the Catapult Fee 23-26-1TB 6H well will develop the Cass Draw Bone Spring Pool (Pool Code 10380). A copy of an e-mail confirming this information is attached hereto as Exhibit B.




