2 EXAMINER DAWSON: Good morning, everyone.
3 My name is Scott Dawson. I'm the lead examiner today.

4 To my right is Leonard Lowe. He's an
5 examiner in the petroleum Engineering Bureau.

6 To my left is David Brooks, counsel to the
7 Division.

8 It's Docket Number 32-18 today. It's about
9 8:23 a.m. on August 9th. We're at 1220 South Saint
10 Francis, in Porter Hall.

11 And at this moment, I'll go through the
12 continuances and the dismissals on the list.

7 Going to page 9 of 19, Case Number 16183,
8 34 on the list, is continued to 9/20/18. Number 35,
9 Case 16184, is continued to 9/20/18. 36, Case Number
10 16231, is continued to 9/6/18.

11 Going to page 11 of 19, number 40 on the
12 list, 16251, is dismissed. 41, 16252, is continued to
13 9/6/18. 42, Case 16253, continued to 9/6/18. 43, Case
14 Number 16254, is continued to 9/6/18.

15 Going to page 12 of 19, number 44, 16255,
16 9/6/18, continued.

17 Number 45, 16258, is continued to a special
18 docket. So 45, 46, 47 and 48, which are Case Numbers
19 16258, 16259, 16260, 16261, those are all continued to a
20 special docket on 9/11/18.

21 Going to page 13 of 19, number 49, 16310,
22 is continued to 9/6/18. Number 50, 16311, is continued
23 to 9/6/18. 51, Case Number 16163, is continued to
24 9/6/18. 52, 16164, is continued to 9/6/18.

25 On page 14 of 19, Case Number 53, 16321,

1 continued to 9/20/18. 54, 16322, continued to 9/20/18.

2 Number 55, Case 16323, is continued to 9/20/18.

3 On page 15 of 19, number 56, Case Number
4 16232, is continued to 9/20/18. Number 57, Case 16233,

6 Going to page 17 of 19, number 67 on the
7 list, 16214, is continued to 9/6/18.

8 And that's all the dismissals and
9 continuances I have.

10 Does anyone else have any further cases
11 that were continued or dismissed?

12 MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, Keith Herrmann
13 representing Compliance and Enforcement Bureau of the
14 Oil Conservation Division.

15 I just want to confirm, on page 7 of the
16 docket, case number 25, Case Number 16041, is continued
17 to September 6.

18 EXAMINER DAWSON: Yes. I said that, didn't
19 I?

20 MR. HERRMANN: Oh, I'm sorry. I didn't
21 hear.

22 And then the next two cases are dismissed,
23 16356 and 16357.

24 EXAMINER DAWSON: Yes. I said that.

25 MR. HERRMANN: Thank you.

1 EXAMINER DAWSON: Thank you.

2 So at this point, we'll continue with
3 Mr. Herrmann, and we'll go to the last case on the
4 docket.
