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STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 16381, Marathon seeks an order from the Division: (1) creating a 1280-acre, more or less, spacing unit in covering Sections 7 and 8, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and, (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying this proposed spacing and proration unit. This proposed spacing unit will be the unit for the Crossbow 23 27 8 WXY 2H, Crossbow 23 27 8 WA 4H, Crossbow Federal 23 27 8 WXY 9H, Crossbow Federal 23 27 8 WXY 14H, Crossbow Federal 23 27 8 WXY 8H Crossbow Federal 23 27 8 WXY 14H, Crossbow Federal 23 27 8 WA 15H and Crossbow Federal 23 27 8 WA 16H wells, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for these wells will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said wells.

Tap Rock has filed competing applications for this area covering portions of Sections 7 and 8 in Case Nos. 16430 and 16431. Marathon asks that Tap Rock's applications be denied and that Marathon's applications be granted in order to best protect correlative rights and promote the prevention of waste.
