2 CHAIRWOMAN RILEY: All right. We have
3 several cases that we heard at the August 20th
4 Commission meeting, and we need to make some final
5 decisions on those.

6 The first one would be Case Number 16040,
7 de novo, the application of the New Mexico Oil
8 Conservation Division Compliance and Enforcement Bureau
9 for a compliance order against Cano Petro of New Mexico,
10 Inc. for wells operated in Chaves and Roosevelt
11 Counties, and Case Number 16359, which is also
12 application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division
13 Enforcement Bureau for a compliance order against Cano
14 Petro.

15 I believe we have orders here that were
16 submitted by counsel. Have you guys had a chance to
17 review those?

18 COMMISSIONER BALCH: I have reviewed it,
19 and I move to adopt it.

20 COMMISSIONER MARTIN: I have reviewed it
21 also and second.

22 COMMISSIONER BALCH: Is it two orders or
23 one order?

24 CHAIRWOMAN RILEY: I believe there are two.

25 COMMISSIONER BALCH: Okay. We may have to

1 do those separately.

2 MR. BRANCARD: I think we combine them into
3 one.

4 CHAIRWOMAN RILEY: It's one order. There
5 are two orders, but for Cano, there's just one.

6 So do we need to vote on this?

7 COMMISSIONER BALCH: You need a motion to
8 adopt it, adopt the order.

9 COMMISSIONER MARTIN: I so move.

10 COMMISSIONER BALCH: Moved and seconded.

11 MR. BRANCARD: Okay.

12 CHAIRWOMAN RILEY: All in favor?

13 COMMISSIONER BALCH: Aye.

14 COMMISSIONER MARTIN: Aye.

15 CHAIRWOMAN RILEY: Aye.
