You have requested an extension of the 120-day time limit given by the Division in the captioned order in which to complete at least one of the captioned well(s) after commencement of drilling operations on the first of the proposed well(s).

The operator spud these wells on March 26, March 29 and April 6, 2018. They could not complete the well due to the scarcity of completion crews within the area and therefore need additional time to complete the wells. Accordingly, you are requesting a 1-Year time limit to replace the existing time limits.
