BRUCE: No. Ascent -- although they were continued, Marathon has withdrawn its opposition. 6 7 They're companion cases to the ones I just mentioned. 8 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. Now, this last 9 group was in the east half-west half? 10 MR. BRUCE: And this is in the west 11 half-east half --12 EXAMINER BROOKS: West half-east half. 13 MR. BRUCE: -- of those same sections. 14 EXAMINER BROOKS: So you're moving across the centerline? 15 16 MR. BRUCE: Yeah. MS. BENNETT: Yes. And we -- Deana Bennett 17 18 again on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian, LLC. 19 We did withdraw our opposition to these two 20 cases so that they could be heard by affidavit during this docket if it was possible, and Mr. Bruce was able 21 to get them together, and so here we are. 22 23 And as I mentioned, though, a moment ago, 24 Marathon is still opposing the Gavilon wells in the east 25 half-east half, as those compete with pending Marathon

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Page 4 wells. 1 2 EXAMINER JONES: But you're not opposed to an affidavit presentation? 3 MS. BENNETT: Not on these because these 4 are the west half of the east half. 5 EXAMINER BROOKS: So you're only opposed to 6 7 the east half of the east half? MS. BENNETT: That's right. 8 9 EXAMINER BROOKS: You're not opposed to the west half of the east half? 10 11 MS. BENNETT: Marathon, for the record, had 12 proposed wells in the west half of the east half. And yesterday I asked that our application for the west half 13 of the east half be dismissed, and I amended one of our 14 applications to remove any confusion and to remove the 15 16 well that was planned to be in the west half of the east 17 half. 18 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. Very good. 19 EXAMINER JONES: For the record, we're 20 talking about Cases 16484 and 16486. 21 Call for appearances. 22 MR. BRUCE: Jim Bruce for Ascent Energy, LLC. 23 Deana Bennett, from Modrall, 24 MS. BENNETT: 25 Sperling, on behalf of Marathon Oil Permian, LLC.

1	MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I handed you
2	Exhibits 1 through 3. They're virtually a mirror image
3	of what I've just sent you. They were just discussed in
4	the prior cases. And the landman's affidavit discusses
5	the land matters. You can see by looking at Attachments
6	B and/or C to his affidavit the well unit orientation
7	and the interest. Marathon owns 25 percent in both the
8	Bone Spring and the Wolfcamp in this well unit. And
9	Ascent intends to drill both Bone Spring wells that's
10	Case 16484 and Wolfcamp wells, 16486. And it
11	contains the usual, affidavits, overhead rates I mean
12	AFEs and overhead rates. And if you have any questions,
13	you can ask me.
14	Again, Exhibit 2 is my Affidavit of Notice.
15	Once again, John Benedict did not claim his mail, and so
16	it's the same thing. I've got a publication. I
17	published notice and would ask that the case be
18	taken be continued for two weeks so that I can get
19	the Affidavit of Publication hopefully from the
20	vacationing "Hobbs News Sun."
21	EXAMINER JONES: Okay. They must work for
22	the federal government or something.
23	MR. BRUCE: And the geologist, his
24	affidavit contains both Wolfcamp and Bone Spring
25	geology. And, you know, the geology, in whatever
